

Class Hours

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Bradley International Airport to Clarion Suites Inn

Exit airport onto Rte 20 East

Follow Rte 20 East to I-91 South (toward Hartford)

Follow I-91 South to exit 35A onto I-291 East

As I-291 East ends, take the exit for I-84 West/I-384 East

Take the exit for I-384 East


Take exit 1 (Spencer St./Silver Ln.)

At end of exit ramp, turn Left

Go to 3rd stop light, turn Left

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Clarion Suites Inn to Radiation Safety Associates, Inc.

Exit Clarion Suites Inn, turn right onto Spencer St.

Follow Spencer St. through 2 lights (over highway)

Take left onto I-384 East, follow for approximately 4 miles.

Take Exit 4 (Highland St./Wyllys St.)

Turn left on Wyllys St., pass over highway, at the light turn right onto Highland St. (Highland St. turns into Camp Meeting Rd.) (You are in a rural area—enjoy the scenery!)


Follow Camp Meeting Rd. for approx 3-4 miles.


At a big right curve, Camp Meeting Rd. merges with Rte 85 South. Follow Rte 85 South for approx 6 miles, to the jct with Rte 94. Turn Left at ‘T’ intersection, staying on Rte 85 South
(Rte 94 turns right)

Follow Rte 85 for another 6 miles to jct with Rte 66 (Traffic light). Turn Left onto Rte 66 (Main St., Hebron)

Pass one traffic light, then take 1st right onto Pendleton Dr.

Radiation Safety Associates, Inc. is the 2nd driveway on Left





DRIVING DIRECTIONS

RSA to Bradley International Airport

Turn right out of RSA's driveway.

Turn left onto Route 66 West. Follow Rte 66 .into Marlborough.

Get onto Route 2 West, and follow toward Hartford.

When Route 2 merges with Route 84 West; move over to far right lane

Take the exit for Route 91 North toward Springfield.

Take exit 40 (Route 20 West) and follow signs to

Bradley International Airport.

AREA ATTRACTIONS

The training center has more extensive information about Connecticut attractions available for attendees to browse through, or go on line at www.state.ct.us/tourism. Here are just a few of the exciting things there are to do in Connecticut.

Mystic Seaport-The world's largest maritime museum, renowned for its spectacular tall ships. Mystic

Mystic Aquarium-Nearly 4,000 types of sea life, including whales and bottle-nosed dolphins can be seen at the aquarium. Mystic

USS Nautilus & Submarine Force Museum-See the first nuclear-powered submarine. This museum recounts history of the U.S. Submarine Force. Groton

Foxwoods Resort Casino-Has the largest gaming facility in the world. Ledyard

Mohegan Sun-A resort casino with a striking design and interior reflecting tribal themes is also nearby. Uncasville

Connecticut River Museum-Learn the history of this lovely part of the state where you can see a replica of America's first Submarine, the 1775 *Turtle*. Essex

Essex Steam Train & Riverboat-A wonderful way to see the unspoiled beauty of New England's most scenic river—the Connecticut. Essex

Gillette Castle State Park-Majestic views from a unique castle high above the Connecticut River. East Haddam

New England Air Museum-The largest aviation museum in the Northeast, with more than 70 aircraft dating from 1909 to modern jets. Windsor Locks

Stafford Motor Speedway-Exciting NASCAR races in the spring and summer. Stafford Springs

Dinosaur State Park-The largest enclosed dinosaur track site in North America, with early Jurassic prints dating back more than 200 million years. Make your own plaster casts of dinosaur footprints. Rocky Hill

Mark Twain House-A Victorian Gothic marvel where Twain wrote *Tom Sawyer*, *Huckleberry Finn*, *The Prince and the Pauper*, and *Life on the Mississippi*. Hartford

Wadsworth Atheneum-One of the finest museums in the country, opened in 1844, with an outstanding collection of Hudson River School pieces, an extensive Egyptian collection and African-American art. Hartford

Beardsley Zoo-Here you can see toucans, ocelots, timber wolves, and other North and South American wildlife. Bridgeport

Military Museum of Southern New England-A fascinating collection of military weapons and vehicles, including the first tank made in the U.S., a 1920 Renault. Danbury

Quassy Amusement Park-For decades, a popular amusement park on the shores of Lake Quassapaug. Middlebury

Lake Compounce Theme Park-America's oldest amusement park, with a new white-water raft ride, Zoomerang roller coaster, children's area, and a waterpark. Bristol

Riverside/Six Flags Amusement Park-Just North of the Connecticut border in Massachusetts. Come and enjoy the largest amusement park around, with an entire section dedicated to water rides. Agawam, MA

National Basketball Association Hall of Fame-Springfield, MA

New England is truly a “compact” area. Within a two hour drive from Hebron, CT you can reach Vermont, New Hampshire, Maine, Massachusettes, and New York.
